WeForest is a dynamic non-profit organisation restoring and conserving forests on a landscape scale, maximising the impact of trees for People, Nature, and Climate. We adopt a holistic Forest Landscape Restoration (FLR) model with a three-pronged approach: Stewardship, Restoration, and Economic Resilience. Through four global programs and 17 tailored, community-led projects across Latin America, Africa, and Asia, we're regenerating 53,000 hectares of forest, growing 82 million trees, and uplifting the livelihoods of 67,000 families.

By recognizing the vital role of forests in mitigating climate change, enhancing water resources, promoting biodiversity, and improving rural livelihoods and resilience, we strive to make a lasting positive impact on the environment and communities.

This role is intricately tied to both strategy and relationship management, connecting in-depth program understanding with high-value, personalised funding initiatives. You will have a key role in exploring new sectors and geographies to enhance our portfolio and diversify our income streams.

In the role of Impact Partnerships Manager, your task is twofold: cultivating new relationships and strengthening existing ones to grow our visibility and strengthen our financial stability.
